

WALK OF FAITH CHRISTIAN CENTER--WEDDINGS

A wedding is a time tradition and sacred institution. A wedding is not for making a mockery of the event or an occasion for merely attracting publicity or for breaking records that are amusing, daring or outrageous. All participants should understand the importance and seriousness regarding the joining together of a man and a woman forever in the eyes of GOD.

There are relatively few must in planning your wedding. However, to have a successful wedding the bride and groom should count the monetary cost. The bride's family sets the size and style of the wedding in accordance with the wishes of the bride. The bride should not make unreasonable request(s). The bride and groom's family should not go into debt over an extravagant wedding. The wedding should be kept within the current financial lifestyle of the bride and groom.

Walk of Faith Christian Center offers a formal wedding ceremony to members only.

(NON MEMBERS MAY BE ABLE TO USE THE CHURCH UPON APPROVAL FROM THE PASTOR)

The wedding should be planned at least four (4) months in advance.

The bride and groom must have a marriage counseling session with the pastor. The purpose of the marriage counseling session is to discuss issues and concerns the bride and groom may have as they transition from a single to a married lifestyle.

(Additional counseling sessions will be scheduled if requested or needed.)

The bride and groom should select a first and second choice of wedding dates and times.

Walk of Faith Christian Center will assign our Wedding Coordinator to the bride to assist the bride with her wedding plans.

The fellowship hall will be made available to the bride and groom for their wedding reception if requested.

It is the bride's responsibility to provide all personnel needed to decorate, set up and clean up the church, fellowship hall and the church grounds before and after the conclusion of the wedding and or wedding reception. .
